Possessive nouns show ownership of something

If a noun is singular, we add 's after the word.

Ex: This is our music teacher's cello.

If a noun is a plural and it's end with s we add

apostrophe (') after the word.

Ex: This is our school teachers' cello.

But if a plural noun is <mark>doesn't</mark> end with <mark>s we</mark> add

's same as for a singular noun.

Ex: The children's voices are beautiful.


